Kaleidoscope Procedures

Notice of pick-up (Bus Notes):

Please understand messages for teachers and their students for notice of daily pick-up (Bus Notes) do not roll over from school year to school year. Please communicate your intention for daily pick-up to your child's teacher. Should there be a change to the daily routine you have set, please notify the office by 2:30 p.m. so there is time to communicate the change to your child and the teacher before school is dismissed. You can call the office at (907)283-0804 to tell us of the change.

Bus Lane Procedures:

The bus lane is a designated space only for bus traffic. Please do not ride bicycles, drive cars or walk at any time in the bus lane. Please do not walk in the berms or on the sidewalks while a bus is moving in the bus lane. It is very challenging for bus drivers and others to see pedestrians when buses are moving through the bus lane. Please pay close attention to duty personnel who will assist in enforcing safety for all people.

Biking and Walking Procedures:

Students are welcome to bike or walk to and from school. If a student will be riding a bike, he/she must wear a helmet. Students are to enter campus in the morning by crossing on the walkway from the sidewalk near the street that is in line with the flag-pole. There is duty personnel there from 8:35-8:55 a.m. daily to meet walkers/bikers. Both will cross the bus lane and enter the school through the front doors. Bikers will walk their bikes to the southside of the school and lock up their bike to the bike rack. Bikers will then enter through the front doors. After school, bikers and walkers meet in a designated location. Students are accompanied through the parking lot and walked off campus by a designated duty personnel.

Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures:

All students, parents and family members must enter and exit through the front doors of the school at all times. For the safety of our campus, other entrances will remain locked. Please make every effort for children to be in attendance and on time daily. Students should not arrive on campus until 8:35 a.m., unless they are participating in a pre-scheduled class. During arrival, you can park and walk your child into school. If you prefer, you can drop your child off by staying in the moving traffic lane and allowing them to exit near the duty personnel at the flag pole. Students will have recess from 8:35-8:55 a.m. At 8:55 a.m., all students will report to their classrooms. Instruction begins promptly at 9:10 a.m. Daily dismissal is at 3:40 p.m. Please park your vehicle and come into the school to pick up your child. Please wait in the hallway until dismissal by the teacher at 3:40 p.m. If for any reason you will not be on time to pick up your child, please call and notify the office at (907)283-0804 before 2:30.
